

## Summary of John L. Ligon file, M346, National Archives.

This file represents payments made by the Confederate Government to John L. Ligon, for rent of his warehouse, purchase of supplies, and renovations done to the warehouse.

- 11/30/1861 \$100.00 paid for "Rent of Factory for use of Prisoners from 1<sup>st</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> Nov." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 12/6/1861.
- 12/31/1861 \$100.00 paid for "Rent of Factory for Prison from 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> Dec." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 12/31/1861.
- 1/31/1862 \$150.00 paid for "Rent of Factory for Prison from 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> Jan. 1 mo." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 2/5/1862.
- 2/28/1862 \$150.00 paid for "Rent of Factory for \_\_\_\_ from 1<sup>st</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>. 1 mo." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 3/11/1862.
- 8/15/1862 \$210.00 paid for "Scaffold taken down in rear of my factory for prisoners (150.00)," and "large rope, destroyed by prisoners (60.00)." Signed by Th. P. Turner. Paid by Capt. Jackson Warner, AAQM, on 8/16/1862.
- 12/15/1862 \$5474.00 paid for "238 Bbls Flour @ 23 per. For use C. S. Mil. Prisons." Signed by Jno H. Winder, BG, and Th. P. Turner, Capt. Commanding. Paid by Capt. Jackson Warner, AAQM, on 12/15/1862.
- 12/18/1862 \$417.00 paid for "Five Hundred Fifty Six (556) pounds of Bacon @ .75 per pound. For use of C. S. Mil. Prison Hospital & Guard." Signed by BG Jno. H. Winder, and T. P. Turner, Capt. Commdg. Paid by Capt. Jackson Warner, AAQM, on 12/20/1862.
- 2/28/1863 \$250.00 paid for "Rent of Factory for Hospital from the 1<sup>st</sup> Jany to 28<sup>th</sup> Feby. 2 Mos @ 125." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 3/2/1863.
- 9/30/1863 \$375.00 paid for "Rent of Building on Main St. for storage of Baggage from the 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> Sept. 3 mos [@] 125" Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 10/1/1863.
- 12/31/1863 \$375.00 paid for "Rent of Warehouse from 1<sup>st</sup> Oct. to 31 Dec. 1863. 3 mos @ \$125." Signed and paid by Capt. Wm. E. Warren, AQM, on 12/31/1863.
- 1/31/1864 \$125.00 paid for "Rent of Factory on Main & 25<sup>th</sup> streets from 1<sup>st</sup> Jany to the 31 Jany 1864 being one month @ 125 per month." Signed by BG Jno. H. Winder, and paid by Maj. John H. Parkhill, QM, on 2/4/1864.
- 3/1/1864 \$200.00 paid for "Rent of Ligons Factory from the 1<sup>st</sup> Feby to the 29<sup>th</sup> of Feby, 1864 @ two hundred dollars per month." Paid by Maj. John H. Parkhill, QM, on 3/7/1864.
- 6/30/1864 \$225.00 paid for "Rent of Factory used by C. S. States as Prison Hospital for Federal Prisoners, from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June 1864 at \$225 per month. Approved by command of Lieut. Gen. Ewell." Signed and paid by Maj. John H. Parkhill, QM, on 7/8/1864.
- 7/31/1864 \$225.00 paid for "Rent of Factory corner of Main & 25<sup>th</sup> Street used by C. S. Government as a Hospital (for Libby Prison) for one month from 1 July 1864 @ \$225 per month. Approved by command of Genl. Gardner, John L. Grubbs, Adj." Signed and paid by Maj. John H. Parkhill, QM, on 8/1/1864.
- 12/31/1864 \$1225.00 paid for "Rent of Factory corner 25<sup>th</sup> & Main Streets used by C. S. as Genl Hospital No. 21 [sic]. Five months from Aug. 1<sup>st</sup> to 31 Dec. 1864 @ \$225

per month. Approved by command of Brig. Genl. Wm. M. Gardner, A A Genl.”  
Signed and paid by Maj. John H. Parkhill, QM, on 3/1/1865.
